This past week was very exciting when we got to one stretch of the road and we were straddling the rut going down hill and then the rut made a Y, it was interesting being behind the wheel and feel the car slipping and knowing that all you could do was pray. The car we have is in no way built for this type of road plus it is a unibody. For a short moment we were balancing on two wheels one on the front right and the other one being the left rear. It was a funny feeling. Stephen was sweating and the children were full of excitement. Pray for this work.

COBIJA – BOLIVIA

The work here continues to grow. Just recently they baptized nine people. God is working. The construction is moving forward but slowly. We are thankful for all those that sent financial help and prayers for this work as well. Please pray for this work.
