RIO BRANCO

God continues to do great things. The mission's conference went very well and the people were challenged to give above and beyond. God is good. The faith promise increased and we are now able to take on more missionaries. Igreja Batista Independente Macedonia is currently supporting seven missionaries but is praying about more. One week after the mission's conference, we had a baptismal. We had the privilege to baptize five people in obedience of the great commission.

In the month of December, we had a surprise visit from our field director, Bro. Robert Smith. We had a good time of fellowship and he was able to visit all the works here. He preached at the church in Rio Branco and challenged the people about serving the Lord in everything. Also in December we had our Christmas program where the real meaning of Christmas was presented. There were many lost people present. The children and adults involved did a great job in their presentation.

The year ended with a wonderful blessing. On the last Sunday of the year there were four precious people who accepted Jesus as their Savior. On the last night of the year, at our New Year's watch night service, one more person was saved. The watch night service was also the celebration of the first year anniversary of this church. We had a great time of food and fellowship. Please pray with us as the Lord continues to deal with lost souls.
