It is just amazing to see how God is at work. On December 31<sup>st</sup> 2006, we had our first service in the new work, Igreja Batista Independente Macednia. God gave us a small number to start with. We challenged the church about Faith Promise giving for Missions. The Lord blessed and the people gave. Just to start with the church is taking up about 350 dollars a month for missions. And from this we have seen God doing great things. A couple of Sundays ago we had 4 saved in Sunday school, 1 in the evening service, and 2 saved on a Tuesday night visitation. God also saved a young lady at the church in Guajar.

There have been times that before service, the children hand out tracts to the people passing by. The tracts run out very quickly. Pray with us, for this work.
