Since we have been here in Rio Branco, we have definitely seen a big difference in the people we worked with before (smaller cities) and the people we work with now (in the capital). This has been a big learning experience for us. The drug use and violence is terrible. But then you see those hurting and know that God has placed you there for a reason. One of the ones saved this past Sunday was a transvestite and former prostitute. The first time I saw him was out on visitation. He was dressed as a woman and ready for work. We invited him to church. The people we were visiting also invited him. Praise the Lord; he is now a part of God's family.

Another case is a young boy named Pablo. Sunday morning at Sunday school he got saved. We went to visit his family that same week, and it was heart breaking to see this young boy inside a crack house. There are so many stories and so many souls to be reached. Please pray.
